

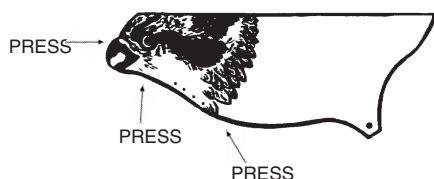
Peregrine Falcon Assembly Instructions

Your Jackite™ Peregrine Falcon is tough, constructed of Tyvek® and a solid fiberglass spar. It is water resistant and highly tear resistant, and will provide you with many hours of flying pleasure.

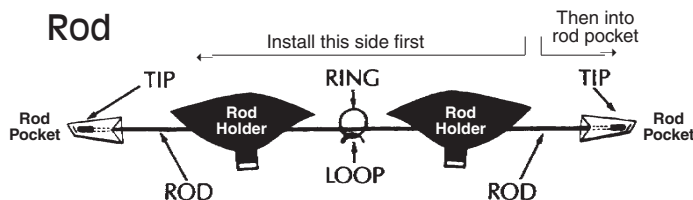
In keeping with tradition, the Jackite™ Peregrine Falcon original was painted using brush and India ink.



Head and Body



STEP 1: Peel tape along edge of head and body. Press together to form head and body.



STEP 2: Insert rod under rod holders, thru ring, under rod holder and into pocket. Then install other end of rod into other pocket

STORAGE: Remove the rod. Hang by the opening in the beak.

DISPLAY: You may desire to share the beautiful design of the Jackite with others as a decoration for your home or office. It's a real conversation piece. Attach wire from the fore ring to the aft ring with a loop midpoint. Suspend by the loop. ENJOY!

LINE: Use 6-10 lb. test line.

INITIAL FLIGHT: If one wing flies slightly low, place a paper clip on the high wing just outside the staple, for a while.

POLE FLYING: Drive a stake into the ground and attach a 20' telescoping fishing pole or cane pole.

JACKITE TRAIN: Attach swivels to each end of a 3 foot line: attach a swivel to the aft ring of one kite and other swivel through the beak of the next kite.
